Year 10 HT1	<u>Christian Beliefs</u> Students should study the influence of the beliefs and teachings on individuals, communities and societies. Common and divergent views within Christianity in the way beliefs and teachings are understood and expressed should be included throughout. Students will learn about a range of different Christian perspectives including Catholic, Orthodox and Protestant. This will cover topics such as the Holy Trinity, and salvation.
Year 10 HT2	<u>Christian Practices</u> Students should study the influence of the beliefs and teachings on individuals, communities and societies. Common and divergent views within Christianity in the way beliefs and teachings are understood and expressed should be included throughout. Students will learn about a range of different Christian perspectives including Catholic, Orthodox and Protestant. This will cover topics such as baptism, and the worldwide Church.
Year 10 HT3	<u>Buddhist Beliefs</u> Students should study the influence of the beliefs and teachings on individuals, communities and societies. Common and divergent views within Buddhism in the way beliefs and teachings are understood and expressed should be included throughout. Students will learn a range of Buddhist perspectives, for example, Theravada, Mahayana, Zen and Pure Land. This will cover topics such as the life of the Buddha, and the Dharma.
Year 10 HT4	<u>Buddhist Practices</u> Students should study the influence of the beliefs and teachings on individuals, communities and societies. Common and divergent views within Buddhism in the way beliefs and teachings are understood and expressed should be included throughout. Students will learn a range of Buddhist perspectives, for example, Theravada, Mahayana, Zen and Pure Land. This will cover topics such as puja, and meditation.
Year 10 HT5	<u>Religion & Families</u> Students will be expected to show their understanding of religion through the application of teachings from religion and beliefs, making specific references to sources of wisdom and authority including scripture and sacred texts. In this unit students will learn about topics such as gender equality, marriage, divorce, and sexual relationships.
Year 10 HT6	<u>Religion, Human Rights & Society</u> Students will be expected to show their understanding of religion through the application of teachings from religion and beliefs, making specific references to sources of wisdom and authority including scripture and sacred texts. In this unit students will learn about topics such as poverty, attitudes to wealth, and social justice.
